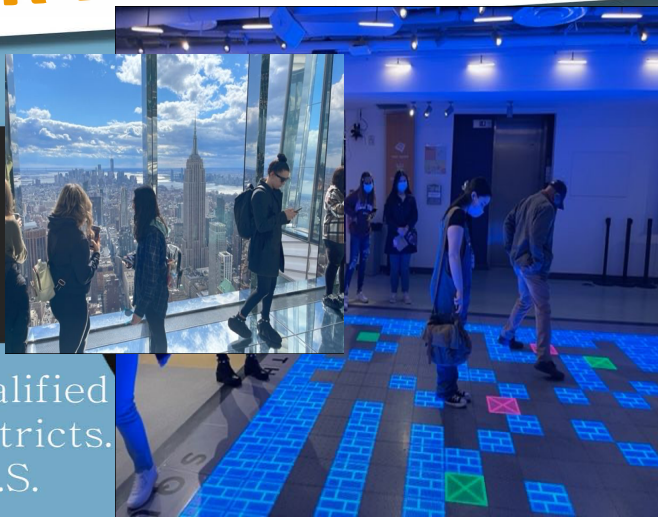


# TEACH MATHEMATICS MAKE A DIFFERENCE



## NSF Robert Noyce Scholarship Program at LIU Post Mathematics & Teacher Education

The program is designed to produce highly qualified mathematics teachers for high-need school districts. Students will graduate from LIU Post with a B.S. Mathematics degree and a NY State teaching certification in mathematics.



### NOYCE Scholars will receive:

- \$20,000 Scholarships per year in both junior & senior years (can be combined with other funding sources)
- Specialized coursework and enhanced teacher training in cooperation with local, Long Island school districts
- Field experiences, mentoring & support that begins at LIU Post and continues after graduation as you begin your teaching career

### Recipients of a NOYCE Scholarship at LIU POST must:

- Have at least junior status (but applications are encouraged before junior status has been reached)
- Participate in program activities and complete the coursework for a NYS Teaching Certification and a B.S. in Mathematics
- After graduation, teach two years in a high-need school district for each year of scholarship support received
